

2026 Information, Lodging & Meals

Class and housing assignments are filled in the order registrations are received!

Our **conference registration** is via an online process which provides immediate class confirmations and your choice of credit card processing or mailing in a check. Register early to get the best chance for your desired classes and housing. Links to the registration site can be found on our website. Our <u>Details</u> page contains class schedules, class/instructor information, general information about the conference, a raffle donation form, product information (you know you want this year's new shirt or vest!), items and supplies to bring, and maps. The general conference fee is \$100. The State of Washington is now charging sales tax on the conference fee. A 3% fee will apply to your total if you elect to pay by credit card.

Using the online registration form, select your class choices from unfilled classes and get immediate confirmation of your schedule. Overlapping classes cannot be selected and class sizes are limited. Once registered, you are responsible for reimbursing instructors for kits made for you. Signup sheets for classes with openings will be available all weekend. Approximate class fees are shown on the schedule. Please bring cash to pay the instructors for their kits. The schedule may be subject to change.

There are three **room and board options** for you: housing with meals, an RV site with meals or a commuter option with meals but <u>no</u> housing. Room and board prices are per person and include 3 nights lodging with linens, and 8 meals. You may choose either single or double occupancy in Olympic View, and single, double or triple occupancy at Mt Baker Village.

The **lodging** facilities are (single / double / triple occupancy, \$\$ per person):

The **Olympic View Lodge** provides 24 rooms with motel-style comfort. Each room has a private bath, a queen size bed and a single day bed with trundle. See it at <u>Olympic View Lodge</u> (536 / 441 / 368).

The second lodging option is **Mt Baker Village** with 28 rooms. Each room has a queen bed, four bunk-style singles, and a private restroom. See it at Mt Baker Village (536 / 413 / 368).

If you prefer **RV/Tent Camping**, that option is also available. For everything from motor homes to dome tents, the RV/Tent Area offers 130 individual sites. Complete utilities, two bath houses, and a laundry are available for campers. See it at RV / Tent Camping (site 150, meals 120 pp)

Great home-style **meals** are served buffet style in the Cedar Lodge Dining Room. You won't find better meals, service, or scenery at any other conference center in the Pacific Northwest. Dietary accommodations include: vegetarian, vegan, gluten free and dairy free, as well as combinations such as vegetarian/gluten free, or gluten free/dairy free. See it at Cedar Lodge (if commuting, meals only pp: 162 B/L/D, 117 L/D). Thursday evening from 5 to 9 PM you can enjoy hospitality, food (\$10 Subway meal on registration form) and friends in the Program Center. Children, guests or single meals will be accommodated by the camp for an additional fee, and there are now two small regulatory fees totaling \$3.20.

Those of you arriving Thursday can **check in** and pick up your registration packet in the Cedar Lodge Raffle Room beginning at 4PM. While you're there, be sure to drop off your raffle donations and buy winning raffle tickets as you register.
